

CHS Orientation Checklist
Wednesday, August 18
4:00-6:00 p.m.

Class schedules and books will be given to students on the first day of school. During orientation, students should find their advisement teacher's room—this is where they will report on August 23! They will also be able to spend time getting to know their way around CHS, find their locker and get used to opening it.

CHS PTSA is pleased to host orientation for the 2010-2011 school year. To make the most of this event, please follow the checklist below:

General notes:

- Bring a checkbook.** Multiple checks will be required! Separate checks will need to be written to CHS and to CHS PTSA and Booster Clubs, etc.

In the hallways:

- Find your student's name on the **lists** posted on the wall outside the media center. These lists will be organized by advisement (or homeroom) teacher. Once you have located your student's advisement teacher's room, please go there to secure a locker and agenda—see below.
- Join CHS PTSA**—tables will be located near the front and gym door entrances. Membership forms were sent in the August newsletter and are available on the PTSA website: www.centptsa.org. Membership forms include volunteer opportunities. AM! Agreements and Directory Sponsorship forms can also be turned in at the PTSA tables. And, Publix Scan Cards will be available here as well.
- Join the Centennial Knights Booster Club.** A table will be set up in front of the gym. Read about this organization in the August newsletter or on-line: www.centennialknights.com.
- Join FFA (Foundation for the Fine Arts).** A table will be set up in front of the auditorium. Read about this organization in the August newsletter or on-line: www.chsffa.org.
- Visit with counselors**—at a table in front of the counselor's office, near the cafeteria.
- Shop at the School Store**—located in the concession stand in front of the gym.

In the advisement teacher's room:

- Pay locker/agenda fee. (\$25).** Lockers will be assigned by each student's advisement teacher who will also distribute agendas. Parents and students will also complete important forms here.

In the cafeteria:

- Visit CHS clubs and activities** many of which will have tables. Please visit these groups and get information about these organizations. Applications, etc. will be available.
- Pick up information about the **MealpayPlus system** used to manage a student's meal account on-line. (www.mealpayplus.com) Meal cards will not be sold during orientation, but a meal account can be established through the MealpayPlus system, or students can bring a check or cash the first day of school. (Fixed meal costs: breakfast, **\$1.15**; and lunch, **\$2.25**. Ala carte selections are also available.)
- Watch a **video** describing CHS departments which will run continuously on monitors in the cafeteria.

In the media center:

- Drop off your **Affidavit of Residence** form (The Affidavit of Residence requires the signature of a notary public. A notary public will be available orientation.) Check the PTSA website to get a hard copy of the appropriate form and instructions.
- Tour CHS.** Student liaisons will lead tour groups on guided tours of the school. These groups will leave from the media center every 15 minutes.
- Pick up **temporary parking information**—in the media center workroom (accessible from the G-hall). Senior students only!

In the front office:

- Administrators will be available to answer **general questions**.
