Location: Front Loop Entrance/Foyer

- 1. **PTSA Membership Table** – Join and become a part of the Centennial Community in supporting our teachers and students.

Location: Learning Commons

- 1. Complete Residence Verification (*9th grade & New Enrollments Only*)
- 2. Submit a **SIGNED** Surface Device User Agreement (*Devices will be distributed at a later date*)
- 3. Pick up Home Access (HAC) login (*please bring a valid driver's license*)
- 4. If English is not your first language, please meet Ms. Jeong and Ms. Escalera to learn about ESOL Services.

Location: Cafeteria

- 1. **Pick up your schedule.**
- 2. If you have a **hole/incomplete (not 6 classes) schedule ONLY**, please go to the table in front of the counseling office.
- 3. ***NEW* Purchase your locker**
- 4. **Pick out your locker and get the combination.**
- 5. Buy Yearbook \$75 (lowest price of the year).
- 6. Pick Up Pre-Purchased Season Pass Cards (Purchase Online at Go Fan)
- 5. **Lunch Account** – Your student's lunch account can be prepaid online, or see Mrs. Peggy Hick's table.
 - Sign up or re-apply for free and reduced lunch.
- 6. **Clinic** - Parents can drop off medication and speak to the Clinic Assistant, Ms. Johnson.
